Ordinance No.5

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to use obscene or abusive language upon the public streets or in the public places within the Village of De Soto or to threaten any person with violence and abuse. In a public or private place, engages in violent abusive, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud, or otherwise disorderly conduct under circumstances in which such conduct tends to cause or provoke a disturbance.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to throw any objects at moving vehicles or persons on the streets, alleys, and or sidewalks of the Village of De Soto.

SECTION 3: It is hereby ordained that all Parents or Guardians shall be responsible for the actions of their minor children under the age of 18 years of age and the penalties they incur in this ordinance.

SECTION 4: PENALTIES

Any person found guilty of violation of any part of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred (\$500.00) and court costs.
