Ordinance No.6

Skateboarding and Bicycles

SECTION 1: It is hereby ordained that all Parents or Guardians shall be responsible for the actions of their minor children under the age of 18 years of age and the penalties they incur in this ordinance.

SECTION 2: SKATEBOARDING

- a) Skateboarding pursuant to state statutes is strictly forbidden on state highways,
- b) Skateboarding by passage of this ordinance is strictly forbidden on all Village Streets, Alleys, Sidewalks, Public Parking areas, and other public ways of conveyance.

SECTION 3: BICYCLES

No person or persons shall operate a bicycle upon the streets or alleys of the Village of De Soto during hours of darkness unless such bicycle is equipped with a lamp on the front emitting a white light visible from a distance of at least 500 feet to the front and with a red reflector and or red light on the rear, so mounted and maintained as to be visible from all distances from 50 to 300 to the rear when directly in front of lawful upper beams of head lamps on motor vehicle. No Bicycle shall be operated on Village sidewalks unless accompanied by a parent.

SECTION 3: PENALTIES

1. First Warning- Verbal
2. Second Warning-Written
3. Third Warning- Citation (issued by Village Board or its designee)

Any person convicted of violating any section of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and court costs.
